## Scorekeeping Tips from DAN

1. When a substitution occurs, THREE things are noted:
a. $\mathbf{S}$ or $\mathbf{S x}$ and the player numbers in the team score
b. Cross out the player number and write the sub number
c. Cross off a substitution in the substitution totals at bottom.
2. Circle that a serve has occurred when it happens, not before.
3. Let the first and second referee's know you are ready with a, "thumbs up."
4. If you are confused or behind, let the referee's know with a, "stop" hand signal.
5. If you are the libero tracker, keep track of:
a. Libero substitutions
b. All other substitutions
c. Correct serving order - if incorrect server serves, notify the second referee after the play is over.
6. In the running score area;
a. Circle $=$ served point
b. / = loss of rally (side out) point
c. Triangle $=$ Libero served point
d. Square = No Serve point (penalty point)
7. When the set (game) is over, X out the set on the:
a. Line up sheet
b. Score sheet
c. Libero tracking sheet
